OUR BEGINNING

ALSA UK was founded during the first COVID-19 lockdown in the UK. Our co-founder, Arisa Reka, was inspired by her colleagues who were working in intensive care and risking their lives to provide care for others. She felt compelled to do more for her community.

With the help of her sister Arijeta Reka, childhood friend Erona Kaciu, and the support of UK Albanian University Societies, they established what was formerly known as the Albanian Student Association.

In the last four years we have been able to grow and broaden our reach to provide services that are inclusive and accessible to all. We are now known as ALSA UK and exist as a community for young people from all backgrounds.

OUR MISSION

In 2020 our mission was to 'Give back to our community'. In time we have developed into an organisation driven to

1. Equip young people with the skills and knowledge needed to overcome barriers and achieve their potential.
2. Use technology to create a supportive network of young people who can learn from and support each other.
3. Ensure young people are at the forefront of shaping the organisation and its mission, reflecting the challenges they face.
4. Leverage the real-life experiences of young people as a valuable tool for learning and development.

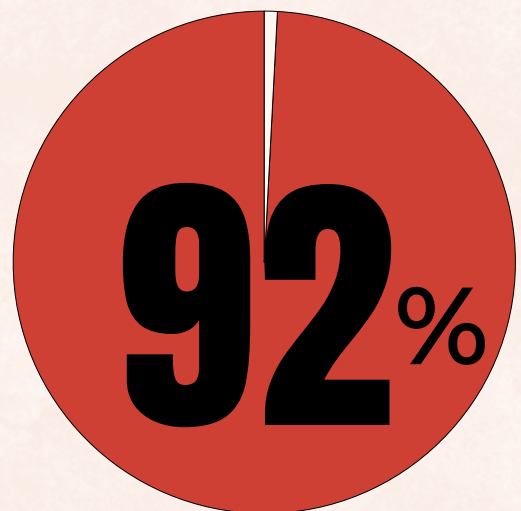
